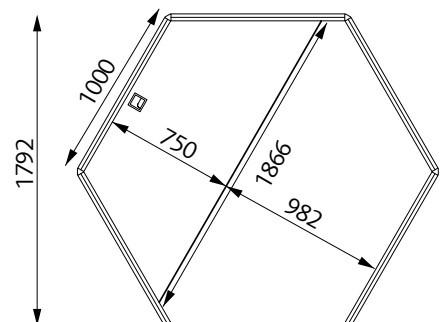
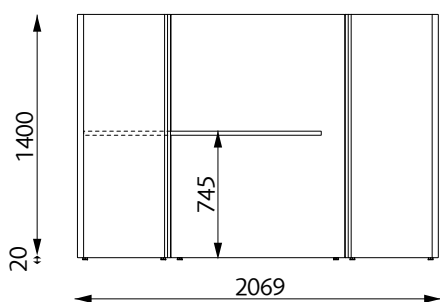

Limbus Hexagon uses a geometric shape commonly found in nature to create efficient focused workplaces. One of the advantages of Hexagon work booths is that you are surrounded by five screens, which creates a more private and cozy work environment than traditional work booths. Another advantage of Limbus Hexagon is that the more hexagons you add in a cluster, the more affordable it becomes per workplace because the workplaces share screens with each other in an extremely efficient way. Limbus Hexagon is assembled with Glimakra's unique connection system. Table tops are available in several different designs and are integrated in the Limbus Hexagon construction.

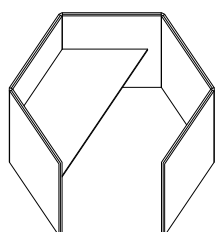

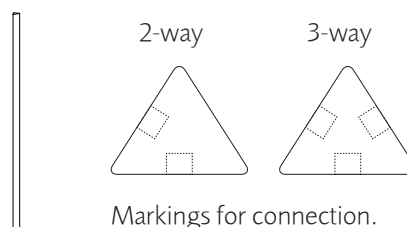
## DESCRIPTION

**Body:** 15 mm sound absorbing polyether (Oeko-Tex) glued on both sides of an 8 mm sound reducing MDF board with a 40 mm frame. Prepared with grey cable feedtrough Ø80 mm between workplaces.

**Upholstery:** Upholstered with fabric on both sides. The nails are covered with a decorative piping.

**Tabletop:** Veneer or laminate with cable feedtrough in aluminium. Located in the middle.

**Mounting:** Connected with connections poles. Connection pole in solid black-stained birch, 3-way and 2-way.



Delivered unassembled.

100% recyclable materials.

Laminate in birch, beech, oak, white, black and grey.

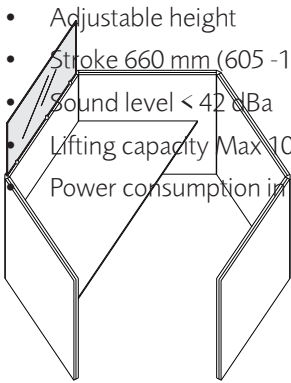
**Addon:** Dimensioned add on screen in acrylic plastic.

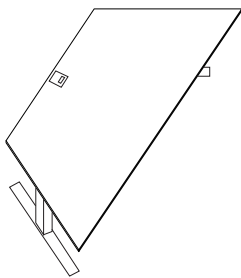
2 x 15 mm sound absorbing polyether on both sides of an 8 mm sound reducing MDF board.

**Fabric:** Blazer CUZ 28 on the inside and Blazer CUZ 30 on the outside. No visible seams. Nails hidden by piping black 190.

Easy installation with connecting poles.

Acoustics evaluated according to SS 25269.

2 fixed tabletops in veneer 22 mm ash.



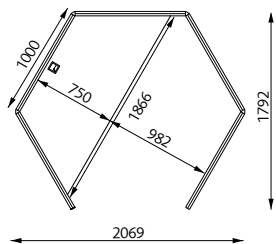

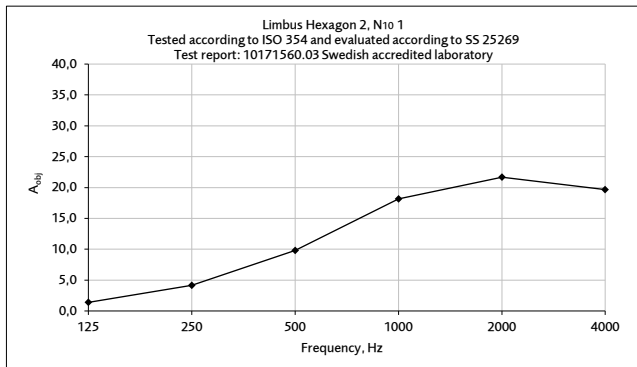
Equivalent absorption area per object (m<sup>2</sup>S/object)

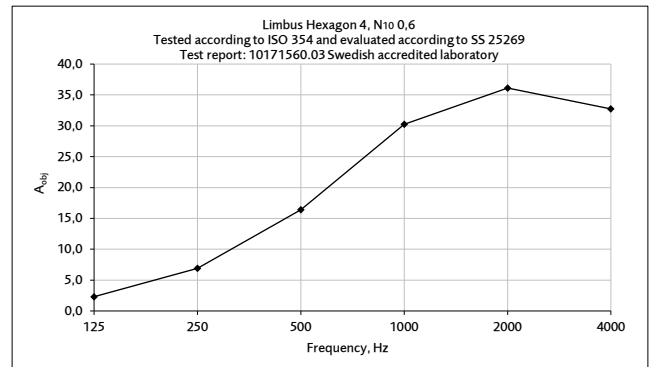
Equivalent absorption area per object (m<sup>2</sup>S/object)

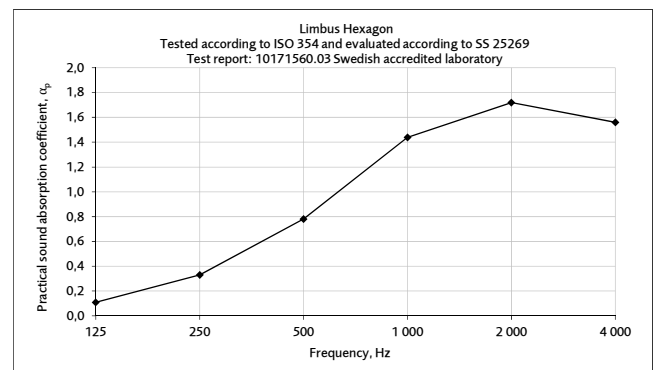


Equivalent absorption area per object (m<sup>2</sup>S/object)
